I am unaware, but this may be standard procedure for all California commissions, boards, etc..

Even more important is that, during the selection process, the potential applicants need to be aware that they will be required to swear to the appropriate oath upon successful selection. Forewarning of this requirement is always a good policy and any hesitancy on the part of the applicant should be cause for their removal.
