Commissioners:

At the last Commission meeting there was a discussion regarding ongoing FPPC filing requirements. This message will supplement that discussion and your obligations.

Assuming Office Statement

When you were appointed to the Commission, each Commissioner was required to file an Assuming Office Statement. Because of the timing of your appointments, whether you were appointed in 2010 or 2011, filing this report satisfied your reporting obligation for calendar year 2011. The Regulation provides:

18723(c) If a person assumes an office specified in Government Code Section 87200 between October 1 and December 31 and files an assuming office Statement of Economic Interests pursuant to Government Code Section 87202, that person need not file an annual Statement of Economic Interests pursuant to Section 87203 until one year later than the date specified in subsection (b).

Annual Statements of Economic Interests

Each year, each Commissioner is required to file an Annual Statement of Economic Interests that covers the "...period since the closing date of his or her last statement filed."

As such, you will need to file a new Annual Statement covering changes that occurred through December 31, 2011. The Annual Statement can be filed anytime between January 1, 2012 and March 1, 2012. We will provide a reminder in January of the need to prepare and make this

filing.
