The Commission will hold a Northern California meeting for presentation of statewide and regional district maps by organized groups. The meeting will be held May 24th, from 9:00 a.m.- 6:00 p.m. at Laney College in Oakland

Groups will have 15 minutes for their presentation of Congressional district maps, 15 minutes for Assembly district maps, and 15 minutes for State Senate district maps. Each presentation of maps will have a period of ten minutes for clarifying questions by Commissioners. During the question and answer period, there will be a two minute limit on the response to any question from a Commissioner.

Organizations wishing to present to the Commission can register online by e-mailing their group's name, contact information, and which type of district maps they will present, to votersfirstact@crc.ca.gov or by calling 866-356-5217. Deadlines for registering to present at the meetings is 5:00 p.m. May 18th. Registration will be on a first come first served basis. Groups may sign up after the May 18th deadline but will be placed last in order of registration if there are still available spots for presentation within the time frame allowed for the meeting. No group will be allowed to sign-up on the actual day of the presentations.
