I am concerned about potential plans to alter congressional districting of the north state. Northern California consists of 3 extremely different regions. The coast is primarily concerned with beaches, fishing, tourism. The central region is mostly agriculture, recreation. The east is mostly ranching and high desert. In addition all have very distinctive travel corridors, with very little cross over east to west. Therefore it is vital to keep north/south districting lines to allow each district a voice for their specific areas of concern.
