Message Body:

I would like to see the Oceanside removed from the 73rd Assembly and be put into the 74th Assembly. I believe the needs of southern Orange County are not the same as the needs of the residents in Oceanside. San Clemente and San Juan Capistrano, to the north of Camp Pendleton, are not as connected - socially and economically - to Camp Pendleton as Oceanside is. The remainder of the 73rd Assembly (Dana Point, Aliso Viejo, Laguna Niguel and Laguna Hills) are completely different (economically and socially) from Oceanside. I don't believe an Assembly member who must focus on the Orange County cities he/she serves can understand the issues facing Oceanside. In contrast, Oceanside is more connected to the 74th Assembly, with its sister cities of Carlsbad, Vista, San Marcos and the coastal cities of Encinitas and Solana Beach. Right now, Oceanside is an "orphaned" city between the 73rd and 74th assembly districts.
