

Commissioners:

I am a registered voter in Siskiyou County, a 65 year resident of McCloud, and a Registered Professional Forester of long standing .

Proposition 20 seemed to offer a fair method of determining district boundaries without the influence of politicians. Of course any method can be co-opted for ones political views if the wrong people are chosen for the task.

In my mind, district boundaries should be drawn to include people and whose cultures and economic interests are closely aligned. To that end I would separate agricultural/timber interests from fishing interests because of the inherent conflicts involved. Likewise I would separate urban environments from those whose livelihoods arise from natural resources.

Boundaries should also include areas connected by infrastructure where possible like the Interstate 5 corridor.

I don't think that interior California and coastal California should be within the same district because of the disparity of interests, both economic and cultural.

Siskiyou County's history, culture and economic well-being have always been mining, timber, agriculture and ranching. That economic well-being has been virtually destroyed by environmental regulations that were well-intentioned but poorly conceived.

As a professional forester, I have watched with dismay as our timber industry has been systematically destroyed by regulatory action by voters outside of our district.

Please keep Siskiyou County connected with Shasta and Tehama not coastal or eastern California.

The lines drawn in 1990 by independent judges probably best represent our concerns, and culture and afford us the best Congressional and State representation.
