Im a PROUD 3RD generation UAW member - My grandfather worked at the Fisher body Plant in Oakland CA - in the 50's which is now the Eastmont mall.

My father also worked at Fisher Body & NUMMI -----

Fisher body then merged with General Motors in the 60's in Fremont ca - which became NUMMI & is now Tesla Motors.

My family has lived in Alameda county for some 80 years I'm here today to say why it's so important

to Keep Congressional District # 13 Intact

The district should follow the 1990 map which was court ordered & objective.

This solid Democratic district in southern Alameda County hugs the **San Francisco Bay's** - eastern shore & includes the cities of **San Leandro – Hayward - Union City & Fremont** as well as a portion of **Milpitas** in adjacent Santa Clara County.

It is 55 percent white - 19 percent Asian - 18 percent Latino - Latinos **comprise** 14 percent of the registered voters & Asians only 4 percent.

The district should include Fremont – Newark - Union City – Hayward - San Leandro - MILPITAS

This district has been together for decades with common demographic & economic LABOR Interests.

Congressional District #13 has been together for almost 40 years It has a common Industrial - labor base. In Southern Alameda county

We do not want to move further south than Milpitas. If we have to take anything else in.
