Dear Sirs:

As a registered voter and resident of Siskiyou County, I believe it would be in the best interests of the citizens of Siskiyou County to be in the same Congressional District as Shasta, Tehama, Glean, Butte, Calusa, Yuba, and Sutter Counties. This group of counties, their towns and cities, have agriculture, ranching, mining and timber economic interests in common. Also, water rights and water use issues that are similar. Highways I-5 and S.R. 99, plus Union Pacific Railroad and other smaller rail lines create important economic, political, and social connections that should not be broken up.
