Subject: Congressional Districting in the Coachella and Imperial Valleys

Message Body:

The southern Colorado Desert valleys should be redistricted as a single Congressional District to include the Coachella Valley as it is currently shown on the Draft and ALL of Imperial County.

The new district would then follow the natural demarcations of the Little San Bernardino to the north, the San Jacinto/Cuyamaca mountain ranges to the west and the Mexico/Arizona political boundaries to the south and east.

This consolidation recognizes the geographic and climatic uniqueness of the southern Colorado Desert as well as the economic and population homogeneity of the area. Imperial County shares significantly more interests with the Coachella Valley than it does with the scattered economic and population base of eastern San Diego County. The same argument can be made for eastern San Diego County; this economic and population base is better served by inclusion with San Diego's Congressional District.
