Message Body:

The maps prepared for San Bernardino and Riverside counties fail to recognize the the two counties are a community of interest. The CRC maps create many districts that take parts of San Bernardino and Riverside counties and put them in districts with communities that have no common interests.

I support the maps presented by Inland Action. Those maps create compact districts that group together cities and communities of interest in the Inland Empire that have common interests in terms of transportation, education, job creation, etc.

I am strongly opposed to splitting the City of Redlands into two different congressional districts.

The Inland Action maps show that it is possible to avoid the splitting of most communities within the Inland Empire, comply with the Voting Rights Act and create districts which include communities with common interests. Those maps should be adopted for the Inland Empire.

The Inland Empire has a population of about 4.2 million people. The Inland Empire deserves districts which serve the Inland Empire, rather than having the Inland Empire cut into pieces and included within districts which primarily serve Los Angeles, Orange and San Diego counties.
