**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LARKSPUR
SUPPORTING THE CURRENT BOUNDARIES
OF THE 6TH CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the California Citizens Redistricting Committee is considering reapportionment of California's congressional districts;

WHEREAS, the City of Larkspur is located within the 6th Congressional District;

WHEREAS, the current boundaries of the 6th Congressional District were established following reapportionment in 1992;

WHEREAS, the 1992 reapportionment established the 6th Congressional District as a cohesive geographical unit encompassing all of Marin County and a substantial portion of Sonoma County;

WHEREAS, Marin and Sonoma Counties are comprised of suburban and rural communities very different from the urban environments of San Francisco and Contra Costa Counties; and

WHEREAS, Marin and Sonoma Counties share key transportation systems, including roadways, railways, and waterways.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council supports the current boundaries of the 6th Congressional District and calls upon the California Citizens Redistricting Commission to preserve these boundaries in its forthcoming reapportionment.




