Dear Mr. Ancheta:

The Rancho Cordova Chamber of Commerce (Chamber) represents approximately 400 businesses in Rancho Cordova and our mission is to promote our community's economic vitality and quality of life through leadership development, advocacy, and education. It has come to our attention that the Citizens Redistricting Commission will be considering new Assembly, Senate, and Congressional district lines in the near future and we wanted to make sure you knew the Chamber's priorities in this process.

We have two primary goals:

**I. Keep Rancho Cordova Intact**

The Chamber respectfully requests fair districts that respect the integrity of the City of Rancho Cordova's boundaries – in other words we would like to be kept intact. Dividing the City of Rancho Cordova in any way marginalizes our community's voice. It has been our general experience, that when the city is divided for district representational purposes, it places Rancho Cordova in an unequal position with other communities that are entirely contained within the district boundaries.

**II. Keep Rancho Cordova with Communities of Interest**

The Chamber respectfully requests that the City of Rancho Cordova be kept with the City of Folsom and the Highway 50 Corridor as communities that share similar interests. The City of Rancho Cordova and the City of Folsom share many common interests, including but not limited to the Folsom Cordova Unified School District, the Highway 50 commercial corridor, a significant number of individuals who live in Folsom work in Rancho Cordova, and both communities share a number of community foundations.
