Re: Congressional District Proposal – City of Rocklin, California

The City of Rocklin desires to go on record regarding our support for the tenets set out by the people of California for fair legislative districts as outlined within the California Voters First Act. We state our support for a legislative district that will preserve the entirety of the City of Rocklin without dividing her people and will further connect the City of Rocklin with communities of like interest.

We feel that the proposed California Congressional Map (Foothills) fails to recognize the common interest Rocklin has with the urbanized communities in the Sacramento Region located along Interstate 80 and the Highway 50 corridor. To group Rocklin with the more rural areas of Fresno County, Mariposa and Madera County, Tuolumne County, Calaveras, Amador and Alpine County is a disservice to our community and we respectfully ask for consideration in aligning the district so that Rocklin is grouped with communities of like interest to include Roseville, Lincoln, Citrus Heights, Loomis and Folsom along with the communities of Granite Bay, Orangevale, Fair Oaks, Gold River, Antelope and so forth.

Therefore we must oppose the California Citizens Redistricting Commissions proposed Congressional District Map (Foothills) as currently drawn for the City of Rocklin on the grounds that it violates the tenets as set forth by the people of California for fair districts that preserve communities of like interest. We ask that the Commission give favorable consideration in putting forth a Congressional District Map that will place Rocklin in a district comprised of communities of like interest.
