As 25-year residents of Fair Oaks, my wife and I have raised our daughter in local public schools and we have been a part of the community--Sacramento County--during this period. We are active in civic affairs, such as the Fair Oaks Chicken Festival and the Hazel Avenue Widening project (on the Citizens Advisory Council), and we are extremely upset at the proposed placement of Fair Oaks into State Senate and Assembly districts that are mostly in Placer County.

The Fair Oaks region, next to the American River, is composed of workers who commute to downtown Sacramento on light rail. We are a world apart from rural Placer County in our interests and concerns. We have always been an integral part of Sacramento County and to cut us off politically from our traditional representatives with these proposed new lines does us a disservice. Please reconsider and include us in districts that are in Sacramento County. Thank you.
