It would appear that an intern with a ruler sitting in Sacramento or Los Angeles came up with the idea of moving Trinity County into the coastal area for Senate and House representation. Historically, a small sparsely-populated part of southern Trinity county relates to the coast, but the rest of the county does its shopping, receives medical care, and obtains its licenses, permits and legal representation from Shasta County businesses and agencies. To force us to have coastal representation in government when most of our business and health affairs are transacted in the Central Valley is stupid, irresponsible and a pretty good example of the needs of political entities being placed above that of citizens. I ADAMANTLY oppose your draft map.It's already bad enough that we are included in the coastal Assembly district. If Trinity is included into Congressional District 1, that would mean that for me a visit to my congressman's nearest field office would be a drive of over 3 ho
