Redistricting Commission:

Thank you for coming to San Jose to receive our input for redistricting. That last meeting here really had a big turnout--so big that most of our Berryessa Citizens Advisory Council (BCAC) neighborhood association representatives didn't get to testify on the new map, which we generally liked. We came 1 1/2 hours early, but the south bay unions had tied up most of the speaking spots. As you probably remember, we want to keep the Berryessa Union School District intact along with Milpitas, "MilpBerry", at least as far south as Mabury. There were some people there claiming that Assembly District 23 was being broken up. That's because AD 23 was formed in 2001 as part of the gerrymandering of AD 20, 22, 23, 24 done by the second speaker. He wanted the boundaries of these changed to assure his re-election and the election of several others lined up to succeed him. Please don't change the maps back again to please them.
