Dear Commissioners:

As Second District Supervisor of the County of San Diego, I am writing to convey my concern with splitting up East San Diego County communities into two districts for state and federal representation. I oppose including Lakeside, Santee, La Mesa, unincorporated El Cajon, Pine Valley, Descanso, Alpine, Jamul, Campo and Dulzura into a shared district with Imperial County. Further, these communities are more tied to the Cities of La Mesa, El Cajon, and Santee.

These East San Diego County communities are similar to each other in demographics and economic interests. If they were to be included with Imperial County, this would significantly compromise and dilute their voices in the political representation process. Imperial County is primarily a desert farming region and the economic situation and community interests differ from those of East San Diego County residents.

East San Diego County shares economic interests, similar geographic characteristics, environmental concerns, and infrastructure including transportation access, technology connectivity and energy and water shortage concerns. Wildfire dangers and risks continue to present huge concerns and closely link all communities in the County of San Diego.

I strongly urge that these maps be amended to keep East San Diego County intact and remain in the County of San Diego rather than Imperial County.
