The Constitutional enactment which governs Commission authority requires that the Commission proceed with transparency, and that full disclosure of all deliberations and observations be made public.



Even if you do not certify maps on Monday, since you have not complied with the Bagley-Keene Open Meeting Act, Government Code section 11125.1, subdivisions (a) and (b), and Government Code section 8253(a)(1) and (2) in that you have not published or posted the proposed Resolution or Document you propose to use to "certify final maps," you nonetheless must permit Commissioner Ward to speak.

The attempt to muzzle the comments and observations of this Commissioner are an outrage. Please permit him to voice his observations.
