In anticipation of the release of the first draft maps on June 10, 2011, I am writing to request the following information:

- 1. Census block equivalency files for each of the four district maps.**
Q2 has indicated there might be a lag between the initial release of the maps and the availability of the electronic versions. Transferring the data via an equivalency file is the easiest means to share data. If there are any difficulties with this request, I would request a discussion between Q2 and our technical team to develop an appropriate solution.
