Dear Records Request Officer:

Pursuant to the California State Open Records Act, this request is for a specific set of documents explained below to be provided as a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request.

Documents of interest are as follows:

All written communications including eMails of Commissioners and Staff to and from Q2 regarding line drawing directions for Assembly, Senate, Board Of Equalization and Congressional Districts resulting from public meetings between 27 May 2011 and 10 June 2011 inclusive. The actual date of any such communications may be outside this range.

Though the designated note-takers (Commissioners and Staff) were tasked to provide a factual statement of instruction and district changes to Q2, the actual content of such documentation is currently hidden from view. The public is unaware of what information has been actually conveyed. These communications are public records which must be disclosed because they affect the product(s) of the Commission, to wit: the various district maps.

(Option 1 - preferred)

Post on the Commission website the documents of interest noted above.

(Option 2 - second choice)

Provide a copy of the documents and other information of mostly a similar nature which has been previously requested by and delivered to someone else.

(Option 3 - to be effected only if Options 1 and 2 are both not to accomplished)

Provide me with an electronic copy as one or more PDF files containing the documents of interest noted above.


If you choose option 3 and before doing any work to satisfy it, please inform me of the fees required for its completion.

If my request is denied in whole or part, I ask that you justify all deletions by reference to specific exemptions of the California State Open Records Act.
