FYI -- To help the commission with its future decision making and motions, I recently asked Janeece about compiling our previously adopted motions so they could be distributed to the commissioners. We already have a summary compilation of our guidelines for preliminary maps, but don't have a comparable document for other motions. Nor do we have a single document that contains the precise language of our previous motions.

The compilation should memorialize our previous policies and help ensure that we are acting appropriately on new motions. I think there should be a balance in allowing the public to come up to the dias. while cynthia is probably right about the low percentage of problem folks, i have 2 issues with people approaching the dias:

(1) first, while some commissioners dont' mind the interaction, because of our tight quarters, other commissioners are impacted (or feel obligated) to interact with the public in these situations thereby impacting all commissioners in that area.

(2)second, i noticed in our final input meetings that more and more people were approaching the dias to shake our hands and/or provide additional comments of one type or another. i think this was partly a result of groups "competing" with one another to make sure they could have "equal" contact with us and i don't appreciate being a part of anyone's attempt to engage with us in that manner.

therefore, to address both of these issues, i would suggest that commissioners take interaction requests from the public on an individual basis and, if a commissioner agrees to talk with a member of the public, to do so away from the dias area. Thank you.

Dan, Kirk and Marian,

After reading the dialogue below, it is clear to me why there was such confusion as to what the actual motion was regarding the Racially Polarized Voting analyst RFI. I too listened for hours to the Long Beach meeting today to determine why my notes seemed to be so off base from what actually occurred during the meeting.

As you can tell by Marian's attempt to decipher what occurred on this motion during the Long Beach meeting, the procedure used for this motion left a confusing and unclear record. When I raised the issue of confusion at the time of the motion, the vice chair offered her attempt at summarizing the motion, but incorrectly stated the motion, which, as a result is now incorrectly stated in the record.

After trying to organize my notes today from the past few business meetings, there are several places in my records which indicate that someone else will provide me with the language of a motion at a later date, or where my notes suggest to get the language of a motion from the video. In reviewing some of the videos, I have discovered that they are not all clear and audible during a motion, so we cannot rely on that source in the future.

In addition, I believe that we should insist on roll call votes on all important motions from this point forward. In watching the video of the Los Angeles meeting, regarding the "percentage" vote on state districts, it is not clear what the actual vote was and by watching the video, one cannot tell who is raising their hand in favor or against. If the Commission does not agree to roll call votes on every motion, for the record, it is necessary that the motion be restated and confirmed by the author that it is correctly stated in the record. When the chair opts for a voice vote, the chair and the clerk each must confirm the number of ayes, noes and abstentions.

In the future, (and I know you will all back me on this), I will ensure that the person making the motion has clearly stated it so all the Commissioners understand what they are voting on. We cannot rely on someone else recording the motion and providing me with the language at a later date. The Commisisoners and staff cannot have an

unclear record or a record dependant on lanauge that is submitted after the fact or outside of a meeting to consturct the record. I know that we all agree that we do not want the record to result in an embarassment to the Commisison, or even worse, to be warranted useless in assisting the Commission's attorneys in any future litigation.

Hi Janece,

Attached is a proposed calendar for April and May showing the locations/dates we think would help produce the best results from the public input hearings. While we want to discuss further the release date for the first public map, we have not addressed that here. Rather, we focus solely on the input meeting schedule.

For all but three dates, we used the original dates in the calendar provided last night, but we have changed the locations. We changed the locations to facilitate line-drawing by completing the input process for particular regions in order, so we may summarize the results and get CRC feedback/direction on how to draw lines, rather than alternating regions/locations from meeting to meeting. For example, we grouped all of the Region 4 (LA area) meetings together, so the Commission can complete gathering input and put that information to good use in line drawing as quickly as possible.

At the end of each of hearings in the four areas, we will provide a summary of testimony/input to the CRC and would like to receive CRC input and direction about how to draw the lines for that particular area. Accordingly, you will see that we have added "CRC Provides Feedback" to four of the meeting dates on the calendar. That feedback and direction will allow us to begin drafting preliminary maps for the given area that we will later present to the CRC for further feedback and direction in the end of May/early June.

In addition, please note the following date changes in the schedule:

1. We added a meeting on 4/13 in order to accommodate the addition of a meeting in Region V, which had none.
2. We cut the meeting on 5/15.
3. We shifted the meeting on 5/26 earlier in the week and also added a meeting that week, so the schedule now calls for input meetings on 5/22, 5/23, 5/24, and 5/25.

Although I did not note the business meetings on this calendar, I don't see any reason to change their dates. In a few places, I left the precise location of a meeting as "TBD," so the CRC should decide where it would like to hold those.

I hope that this calendar is acceptable. We believe that this schedule will greatly improve our ability to assist the CRC with drawing lines in the tight time line provided.

Please note that while we also want to discuss the timing of the release of the initial map to the public, we are just focusing on public input meetings for now. We will be in touch about timing of the release in the near future.

Hi Janeece,

We didn't cut Santa Rosa, but we did move it to later in the process. In our proposal, we explain that we will have line drawers with primary responsibility for four different areas of the state. Santa Rosa is in Region 8, which along with Region 7 counties, will be one of the four areas of concentration. Regions 5, 6, and 9 will be another. The idea was to keep the Region 5, 6, and 9 hearings together, so we moved the two Region 6 meetings up to 4/14 and 4/15 and added the 4/13 meeting to accommodate a Region 5 meeting to have them paired with the two Region 9 meetings. To keep the Region 7 and Region 8 hearings together, we moved Santa Rosa and Rancho Cordova to 5/20 and 5/21, grouped with the other Region 7 and 8 locations on 5/22 to 25.

Keeping the regions together in the manner laid out in the proposed calendar will enable us to consolidate public input and provide it to the Commission quickly, receive Commission feedback and direction, and start drawing lines based on that direction as quickly as possible.

I sincerely apologize for the inconvenience of moving the 4/14 and 4/15 meetings, and hope that it will not be too much of a hardship. Since we knew the process was already quite far along for the 4/9 and 4/10 meetings, we did not attempt to change those locations and instead moved the Region 5 and 6 meetings forward. Please let me know if you need further information.
