Dear Commission members:

Please consider following the example of the City of Santa Monica and post a daily unofficial "meeting wrap up." Santa Monica does a great job of listing "just the facts": the agenda items covered, actions taken by the Commission, and summary of what the Commission decides will be covered the next day: <http://www.smgov.net/departments/council/wrapup.aspx>. Note that this is not minutes of the meeting. It is much shorter and simpler. This would be something that you could request the Secretary of State staff perform for now, and your executive director could take over once he/she is on board.

This is particularly important given the open-ended nature of the Commission's agendas; the variability of discussions from day to day; and, in particular, given the Commission's goal of reaching out to the "typical Californian," those who do not have the free time to watch each and every meeting and who cannot afford to pay a lobbyist to watch and summarize the Commission's meetings for them.
