**Subject:** Meeting Schedule is Missing

While I understand that the Citizens Redistricting Commission's (CRC's) whole schedule of upcoming meetings can not be projected into the future, when the CRC adjourns for the day, your web site (<a href="http://www.wedrawthelines.ca.gov">http://www.wedrawthelines.ca.gov</a>) needs to have posted the day/date & time when the CRC will next reconvene. And when the CRC goes into closed door session, for example, to examine candidates for employment, the web site really should have some indication of when the Commission will reemerge into open session.

Currently, even those paltry bits of information are absent. What that means to the public is that if we've missed the end of a session, we have to "tune in" every day at 9:30 a.m. to see if the CRC is in session; similarly for the CRC returning to open session.

I suggest this notice to the public of the CRC's reconvening could be shown on the Home page, or at the very least, a notice to those interested citizens who have "...Sign[ed] up to be notified of news, updates and more!" I've signed up, but haven't heard a peep from you folks at the Sec. of State's office, or the predecessor Audit office. (I'll try signing up again.)
