The new census will give us a better indication. The Angeles National Forest is our "backyard." We are bounded by the recently established Pleasant View Ridge Wilderness to the south.

The nearest communities to the south are Monrovia, Duarte, and Glendora; which are about 23 miles "as the crow flies" through the Angeles National Forest. One would have to drive 85 miles from our community to the see Senator Bob Huff of the 29th District, who represents 25% of our community. (If the Station Fire had not destroyed the Angeles Crest Highway, the route would still be 65 miles.)
