I was recruited by the United Nations in 2000 to be a senior member of their electoral assistance team and since then have been directly involved in supporting elections in East Timor, Mexico, Afghanistan, Liberia, and Sudan in addition to advising the UN and the international community on a variety of other elections.

I met Ms. MacDonald and Ms. Glaser in Mexicali in 2007 when I arranged for them to join a group of US election administrators that were invited to observe that year's state elections in Baja California.

From my discussions with them on that occasion and more recently in conjunction with my work promoting awareness of Article 29 (Political and Public Life) of the international Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities, I have found both of them to be highly professional, knowledgeable of the enormous range of technical issues involved in election administration, able to explain those issues and their associated options in a manner that is concise and clear, and committed to the highest professional ideals of quality, transparency, and non-partisanship.

I there believe that Ms. MacDonald and Ms. Glaser are fully qualified and able to provide a full range of impartial advisory support to the Citizens Redistricting Commission.
