## **Citizens Redistricting Commission** *Announces Voting Rights Act Staff Attorney Position*

SACRAMENTO, CA (March 9, 2011)

The California Citizens Redistricting Commission (CRC), which is charged with drawing Legislative, Congressional and Board of Equalization districts boundaries, is seeking applications for a staff attorney with prior experience in VRA matters. The deadline for application submissions is 5:00 p.m. March 14, 2011.

The Commission's Legal Advisory Committee will review all submissions on March 15th and schedule interviews of the most qualified applicants for March 17th. The committee anticipates making a final recommendation to the full Commission on March 18th. The full Commission will make the final decision.

California's first Citizens Redistricting Commission is a new 14-member Commission charged with redrawing California's Senate, Assembly, State Board of Equalization, and Congressional districts based on information gathered during the 2010 census. The Commission must draw the State Senate, Assembly, State Board of Equalization, and Congressional districts in conformity with strict, nonpartisan rules designed to create districts of relatively equal population that will provide fair representation for all Californians.
