Re: Long Beach and the LA/Orange County Line


The southeast corner of Los Angeles County is unique, organic and historical. The smaller Orange County beach communities on the other side of the San Gabriel River have not shared the same history or culture.

Naples, the Peninsula and Belmont Heights & Shore were established on or after 1903 and were always oriented to Long Beach and Los Angeles County. You could not even drive to Seal Beach, and the first connection was the PE trestle over the Alamitos Bay. We still reach it by crossing a bridge.

Utilizing the Los Angeles County line along the San Gabriel River on the **east** and Redondo Avenue on the **west** maximizes the ethnic attributes of the 37th Congressional District and, going **north** creates a new and robust 46th CD. This would eliminate the egregious gerrymandering of the present 46th which stretches from Huntington Beach to Palos Verdes.

Please respect our community and geographic integrity and use the county line for your boundaries.
