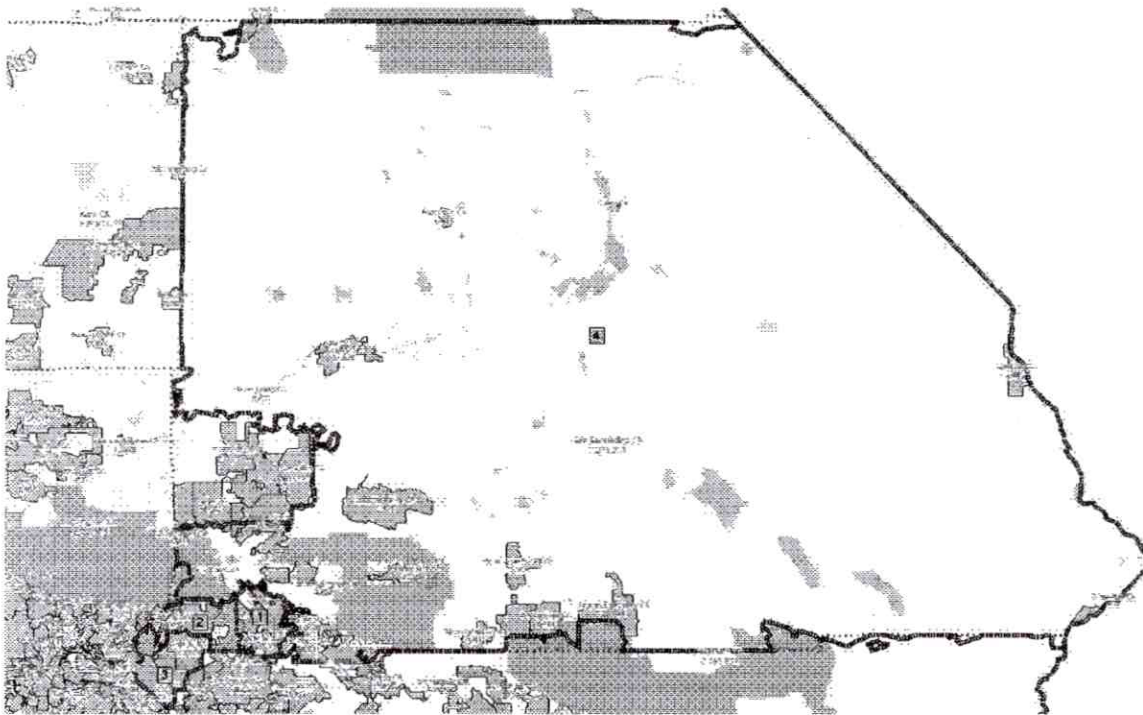

The east San Bernardino valley communities and unincorporated areas that are east of San Bernardino city constitute a single community of interest area, that is a single market area for economic commerce, transportation, education and cultural affairs. This area includes the valley cities of Loma Linda, Redlands, Highland, and Yucaipa, as well as the mountain cities and unincorporated areas of the San Bernardino mountains. In the interest of acceding to the desires of mountains residents to be assembled together, the mountains' north slope in San Bernardino County from Wrightwood on the west through the Lucerne Valley and then to Yucca Valley and the Riverside County boundary can extend this area. Speaking to the assembly district issue: The remainder of northern and eastern San Bernardino county can additionally extend the area. The outlier communities to this arrangement would be the high desert cities of San Bernardino county (Adelanto, Apple Valley, Hesperia, Phelan and Victorville) which would likely find common interest with the high desert Los Angeles county cities of Lancaster and Palmdale.

In the attached illustration the area with the label "4" is the approximation of the described area suitable to constitute an assembly district area. (Boundaries near the county line should follow the county line.)
