REGION I

San Diego Region- area population 3,269,841. (PEP 2009) 9% of the state’s population. This region includes San Diego and Imperial counties.

The city of San Diego is the second largest city in the state, behind Los Angeles.

Industry: San Diego’s economy is led by manufacturing, particularly in the areas of shipbuilding and repair, industrial machinery and computers, metals production, and the manufacture of toys and sporting goods.¹ Imperial County is one of the most productive farming regions in California with an annual crop production of over \$1 billion. Agriculture is the largest industry and accounts for 48% of all employment.²

REGION II

Inland Empire Region- area population 4,224,851. (PL94-171 2010) 11% of the state’s population. This region includes San Bernardino and Riverside counties.

San Bernardino is the largest county in the continental United States by area. Riverside County has had substantial growth in population in recent years due to people moving away from big cities such as San Diego and Los Angeles. Riverside’s population has grown by just over 555,000 between 2000 and 2008. (US Census). The cities of Temecula and Murrieta account for 20% of the increase in population of Riverside County between 2000 and 2007. (US Census)¹

Industry: inexpensive land prices (compared to Los Angeles, San Diego and Orange County), a large supply of vacant land, and a transport network where many highways and railroads intersect have made the Inland Empire a major shipping hub. Some of the nation's largest manufacturing companies have chosen the Inland Empire for their distribution facilities. While urbanization continues to cut in to agricultural lands, the inland empire still produces substantial crops.

The city of Anaheim is home to 336,265 residents, slightly less than Santa Ana with 324,528 residents, making it the second largest populated city in the county.¹
