


The Split of the Westside

Notes of variation:

West Hollywood includes points East of La Cienega.

The West Los Angeles VA shares staff and facilities with UCLA so is included with the East Section.

The beach areas of Venice are most in common with the Ocean Park community of Santa Monica (and not with Marina del Rey) so is part of the West Section. The inland areas of Venice are most in common with the Mar Vista & Palms areas so are included with the South Section.

Ladera Heights are a part of the Inglewood School District but have seen themselves apart from the City of Inglewood so are still included with the South Section.

Creating these sections result in the following populations:

West Section – 244,230

(71.2 % White, 12.2 % Hispanic Origin, 2.8 % Black, 9.8 % Asian)

East Section – 222,706

(70.1 % White, 10.0 % Hispanic Origin, 3.4 % Black, 12.2 % Asian)

South Section – 220,870

(47.7 % White, 47.7 % Hispanic Origin, 9.6 % Black, 14.3 % Asian)

And the natural extension of these sections would be:

West-More (extend to the North to take in the balance of the Western arm of Los Angeles County) – 57,801 (total of 307,031)

(Additional area: 80.2 % White, 7.6 % Hispanic Origin, 1.4 % Black, 7.4 % Asian)

East-More (extend to the East towards Highland & beyond) – 126,153 (total of 348,859)

(Additional area: 56.7 % White, 17.6 % Hispanic Origin, 12.1 % Black, 10.0 % Asian)


South-More (extend to the South along the coast) – 148,045 (total of 368,915)


(Additional area: 69.0 % White, 14.6 % Hispanic Origin, 2.0 % Black, 9.6 % Asian)

None of these areas with their additions make a complete district so allow the drawing of further lines to fit the larger need of the redistricting plan. The West Section (with West-More) can be drawn Northwest into Ventura County towards Oxnard or Thousand Oaks. The East Section (with East-More) can be drawn Northeast into Hollywood or Southeast through Hancock Park (or North into the San Fernando Valley). The South Section (with South-More) can be drawn East through the Baldwin Hills or Inglewood (or both) or Southeast into Torrance or the Palos Verdes Peninsula.


