RE: San Diego County

-Regarding Congression District 53 (I believe it is), Susan Davis, presently is a thin East-West swath including La Jolla (white/Jewish upper income, Linda Vista (mised Asian-Hispanic black low income) and Southwestern Lomita (Afro-Asian low income?).

-Target 700K, please include UCSD community (La Jolla & University City), Clairemont, Bay Park, Serra Mesa & Linda Vista (all communities on the Mesa square between Roads 52 N, 5 W, 15 E and 8 S.

-Delete - Lomita and Southwest Afro-Asian communities.

-Regarding State Senate District 39, it's presently: Camp Pendleton, North County San Diego, including city of Escondido (surburban/Rural) to San Diego North City (urban).

-Target 900 K, including most of urban San Diego City (1.3 Million) including La Jolla-University City (UCSD) in the North to border of National City (Hispanic) in the South.

-Delete all those communities now included in San Diego City District 1 that are in the City of Poway (not San Diego) School District, which include Del Mar Ranch, Carmel Ranch, Rancho Penasquitos & Rancho Bernardo.

-Regarding State Assembly District 78, it is presently San Diego City South of La Jolla, including Cities of National City and Chula Vista West to border of City of Imperial Beach.

-Target 450 K, including La Jolla-University City (UCSD Community), south to National City (Hispanic).

-Nest with Assembly District for South Bay communities of Cities of Coronado, National City and Chula Vista West (Both Hispanic), and City of Imperial Beach, including San Ysidro area (City District 8).

San Diego City and South Bay Communities have the following in common:

-Transportation - One Trolley, the Blue Line, unites them, and it is easy to transfer to buses downtown between San Diego and Chula Vista areas.

-Geography - San Diego and South Bay soth sit on mesas, bays (Mission Bay and San Diego Bay) and beaches (La Jolla to Imperial Beach).

-History - San Diego and South Bay are both the oldest, most urban sections of San Diego County, one spreading north from downtown, and one spreading south.

-Parks - Residents of San Diego & South Bay frequent each other's parks, including Balboa Park in San Diego, Coronado Hotel Del Beach, Chula Vista Nature Center, and Tijuana Slough Sanctuary (in Imperial Beach).

-Income - San Diego & South Bay are largely made up of small houses, condos & apartments,

mid to low income, and very urban in character.

NOTE: It is known that Riverside Registrar of Voters failed to count 12,000 mail-in votes for State Senate candidate Mary Salas from Chula Vista, and there is a bias against Chula Vista Hispanic community on the part of Riverside, so please delete Riverside from the Chula Vista Assembly or Senate district.

-The border communities of Imperial County who wish to be attached to the San Diego County communities can be matched with the Eastern portion of Chula Vista and San Diego City who have more suburban populations.
