Oceanside and Carlsbad should be part of a "coastal corridor" district and not grouped with the inland communities during redistricting.

Here are some of the reasons for keeping Carlsbad in a coastal grouping:

- 1) Strong common "coastal" identity' and shared social and economic interests
- 2) Similar demographics
- 3) SANDAG regional planning identifies "north coastal" vs "inland" areas
- 4) Media markets identified as coastal vs. inland markets
- 5) Some overlapping school districts
- 6) A common hospital district
- 7) Common I-5 and Highway 101 transportation routes

Camp Pendelton down the coast including Del Mar would be a fit for this area. Including La Jolla or Vista would make the numbers.
