Dear Commission,

To properly redistrict San Diego County's congressional districts, CA-53 should be your starting point.

CA-53 as presently drawn does not benefit the communities within its boundaries. Utilizing Interstates as boundaries enables the target population of 702,905 to be realized.

This can be accomplished by:

- 1) Moving the boundary line in place in Imperial Beach further east than 14th Street to Interstate 5;
- 2) Establishing either Interstate 5 or 15 as the eastern boundary;
- 3) Including La Jolla west of Interstate 805 in CA-53;
- 4) Expanding CA-53 northward to include Solana Beach, Del Mar, and Encinitas along the coast; and
- 5) Removing Lemon Grove and Spring Valley from CA-53 because their removal would permit the remaining 4 districts to be re-drawn with relative ease.

If accomplished, CA-53 will be a community of interest as it will encompass the coastal community of San Diego County.
