Subject: apparent errors in Asian population %ages in DataProfile for Region IV Los Angeles County

Hello,

I printed out the data charts for Region IV Los Angeles County posted April 27.

I am concerned that the Column labeled %Asian has inaccurate figures in it. I looked at communities that have high Asian--Chinese, Korean, Vietnamese-- populations such as Monterey Park, Cerritos, Diamond Bar, San Marino, San Gabriel, Alhambra, Arcadia, and Walnut.

In each case the % Asian population is listed as less than 0.5%. Only in cities such as Lancaster, Palmdale and Lomita is the % Asian greater than 0.5%. Also, when I added the 5ages for the 5 listed races, Whittier totalled 96+%, but Monterey Park totalled 33.18%, Rancho Palos Verdes 68.91%, Cerritos 37.3%, MOnterey Park 33.18%, Alhambra 46.1%, Arcadia 40.25%, Lancaster @96%, Palmdale @97%, Diamond Bar 47.03%.

I think that the data in these charts needs to updated to reflect the actual 5age of Asian background residents.

In Rancho Palos Verdes the %age in the table translates into 28 people of Asian descent. There are probably that many on one street!!

In Cerritos, which has thousands of Asians, the %age on the chart comes to 93 people!! I hope that this data sheet will be fixed very soon. The public needs to have a clear and

factual set of data to use.
