CITIZENS REDISTRICTING COMMISSION PUBLISHES SCHEDULE FOR PUBLIC INPUT HEARINGS

The Citizens Redistricting Commission (CRC) has finalized its initial schedule for public input hearings where they will receive testimony on how the Commission should establish the new legislative districts.

The CRC has established two meetings where they envision statewide organizations presenting maps that they intend to submit to the Commission for consideration. These meetings will be held at the end of May, with one meeting in Northern California and one meeting in Southern California.

The Commission has reserved May 31 – June 10 as a timeframe when they intend to meet in Sacramento and work with technical staff in order to develop the first draft statewide maps and has established a goal of having the first draft map completed by June 10th.

Once the first draft map is released the CRC will hold additional hearings across the state. While the Commission has established some hearings in June, they are reserving decisions on when and where to hold additional hearings until later in the process.

The initial round of hearings will be held in April and May as detailed below.
