Dear Commissioners,

The Tri-Valley area in Northern California is comprised of the uniquely related and adjacent cities of Danville, Dublin, Livermore, Pleasanton, and San Ramon. I urge you to keep our community whole and contiguous in redistricting.

The Tri-Valley stands alone as a regional community in traditional and non-traditional ways. We were one of the first cities to form cross county regional transportation solutions through the formation of the **Tri-Valley Transportation Council (TVTC)** nearly 20 years ago, created a regional transportation fee and implement capital improvement projects, create the **Tri-Valley Vision 2020** coalition, created the **Tri-Valley, Convention & Visitors Bureau**, jointly lobby our Congressional representatives with one voice speaking for all cities within the Tri-Valley, hire a lobbyist to represent the Tri-Valley, created the **Tri-Valley Council of Mayors (TVC)**, created the **Tri-Valley Innovation Network (TVIN)**, created the **Tri-Valley Business Council (TVBC)** common and overlapping utility districts and a strong consensus of our business communities working together in the Tri-Valley. Among the five cities, we have agreements to share and support resources to avoid duplication thereby creating complimentary resources while being efficient in the use of public funds.

As you make your decisions about State Senate, State Assembly, and Congressional lines, I **strongly** urge you to keep the **Tri-Valley whole**. Our economic, community values and collaboration efforts are uniquely intertwined and dependent upon each other's success. Our continued success depends keeping our area under common leadership.
