3. In the near vicinity (parking lot) for the hearing location (???)
4. For how long prior to the start of any meeting (???)
5. For how long following the conclusion of any meeting (???)

These responses (???) define how many security officers may be required for any meeting and for how long.

Of course, ANY PROBLEM which appears in the meeting video or alerts the news media would be a significant publicity nightmare for the Commission. To that end, your videographer should be instructed to avoid broadcast of any problem that might occur.
