Hello,

I am a three-year resident of the City of Long Beach, and I believe it is important to create cohesive, representational congressional districts here in California.

It makes no sense to me to have a third of our city represented by a district (CD 46) with most of its constituents live in Orange County or Pacific Palasades.

I also feel that areas to the north of Long Beach (Compton, Willowbrook and Watts) would be better represented by other CDs and their leaders (33, 35 and 39).

I would suggest the following boundries of a newly configured CD 37:

East: West of the San Gabriel River and/or Orange County Line.

South: Shoreline of the City of Long Beach, and the Ports of Long Beach and Los Angeles.

West: East of I 110, to include the cities of Carson and Wilmington

North: South of the northern City limits of Carson and Long Beach and Lakewood.


