
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San Bernardino Valley Central District (CD-43)

Description:

- This area encompasses San Bernardino, Colton, Rialto and Fontana which is a suburban area that is economically and culturally similar and interrelated
- Currently this is largely the CD-43 area, which is altered for population adjustment
- The west boundary is at Milliken Ave from the Riverside county line to the foothills
- The east boundary is at Victoria Ave, the San Bernardino airport, and Tippecanoe Ave
- The area is completely contained in the valley, and includes no mountain communities or areas outside San Bernardino County


This area constitutes a cultural and economic market area, with historic ties among the people, groups and communities in the area.




East Valley and East San Bernardino County (Revised CD-41)


The East Valley communities and cities (Highland, Loma Linda, Mentone, Redlands, Yucaipa), San Bernardino mountains and eastern desert make up the revise of CD-41. There are no communities of any other county included, as it is completely constituted of San Bernardino County. It includes the I-15 corridor north of San Bernardino to Barstow and then all of San Bernardino County south and east of the I-15 highway to the state border.

The mountain communities and the East Valley communities are linked through common transportation, economic and cultural markets.

West End and high desert San Bernardino County (Redefined CD-25)

The high desert district is extended south to include the West End cities of San Bernardino County (Ontario, Montclair, Rancho Cucamonga, Chino and Chino Hills). The parts that were previously in Los Angeles County are removed. The northern extent is the area east of the Sierra Nevada ridge to the Nevada border and north of I-15, as it was in the prior CD-25.
