Hello, my name is Glen Wilson and I'm a resident of the West San Fernando Valley community of Northridge. I'm the VP of Administration for Northridge West Neighborhood Council which is one of Los Angeles City's ninety-three Neighborhood Councils.

- 1)I suggest that you can keep the entire West San Fernando Valley together in the State Senate, Assembly and Congressional seats.Please use Mulholland Drive as the southern most boundary line for the West San Fernando Valley. When drawing the line so that the San Fernando Valley north of the 118 Freeway to include neighborhoods served by the Neighborhood Councils like, Chartsworth, Granada Hills North and Porter Ranch. Those three communities are within the City of Los Angeles and within the San Fernando Valley.
- 2)I suggest that you can keep the entire East San Fernando Valley together in the State Senate, Assembly and Congressional seats.
