This letter is to make a minor correction to an earlier letter I sent today.

In a proposal for assembly districts in Kern County, I said that one proposed for the agricultural areas in western Kern County would have about 190,000 residents in the Kern County portion. In fact it would have about 235,000 residents, with about 230,000 residents in adjoining counties to the north, most likely Tulare County.

I forgot to include the 45,000 or so residents of Metropolitan Bakersfield that would need to be excluded to meet the target assembly district population of about 465,000.

(Metropolitan Bakersfield as defined would encompass the Bakersfield, Rosedale, and Greenfield county Census subdivisions, excluding the large southern part of Census Tract 32.04, which is rural.)

This would not otherwise materially affect the analysis in the earlier letter. Thank you for your consideration.
