Additions:

Antioch  
Fairfield  
Suisun City

What do Antioch, Fairfield, and Suisun City have in common?

Currently these three cities are in Congressional District 10.

The bachelor's or higher degree attainment among those age twenty-five and older is lower in the three cities than it is among all Californians age twenty-five and older.

No one race has a majority in any of the three cities. People of color are the majority in each of the three cities.

Each of the three cities has a lower median age than the state average.

The source for the educational attainment and median age data is the 2005-2009 American Community Survey five-year estimates.
