I attended the meeting in Santa Rosa and heard a strong consensus for not including San Francisco with Marin for the Senate District. I heard the issues with the Assenbly district and the population limit which doesn't lend itself well to cutting up Sonoma. With all due respect to the residents of Sonoma I would recommend a district of all of Marin and a gradual lifting north from the Marin County Line to bring in the 200k people needed for this district. The towns in the southern and central (along 101 corridor) parts of Sonoma have the most in common with Marin and us with them. I don't know where the line would end up but unfortunately it appears that the size of Santa Rosa would appear to exclude it from this particular district. In the case of the other districts we request to have Marin combined wity Sonoma.
