"I am a homeowner at Sunset, San Francisco. I have a family of 5 including an autistic son. I strongly believe in fair redistricting by making San Francisco whole.

I have been sued over the past 1.5 year by a professional renter scammer. This scammer caused my family (with an autistic son) strong emotional distress. I lost my job because excessive time away from work to handle the series of lawsuits and bodily injuries bought by the scammer living in my home. After a long 1.5 years, my series of cases are luckily resolved by the law firm of MacDonald, a member of Small Property Owners of SF, which now I'm associated with. Because of the lawyer's help, we didn't let the renter scammer prevail.

However, I still lost \$50k over the ordeal, and it is the money I doesn't have with my husband's single income of \$1800/month. Still, I feel it is the right thing to do, better than giving in to the scammer's extortion of \$20K!

I am still not able to get over the emotional distress from the renter scammer's harassment, and not able to hold a job. Any mention of "police", will make my autistic son hide in the closet lumping all of the clothes on himself, because he has been threatened many times by the renter to bring over the police to take him away. We will have a long time to get back to our normal life from this distraught experience.

The Sunset district in San Francisco being separated to a different congressional district prevents these unfair treatments caused by the Rent Control laws been voiced to the top level. Sunset and the rest of the SF is in one city, but since we are pushed to a different district, Mrs. Pelosi couldn't handle my case, and Mrs. Speier can't do much about it. This disconnect cause big harm to me, my family and my community. Please make the districting right so we can be treated fairly."
