Dear Editor and Citizen's who may be concerned,

We oppose the Redistricting of this area to coincide with the area along the coast. It will cut our representation in half. This area along the I-5 corridor is completely different than the area along the coast of northern California, different in economic, cultural, environmental and social structure.

We want to be structured as the Judges proposed in 1990. The area will be on both sides of I-5.

There are changes being put upon us by the NGOs or Non-governmental organizers who want to rewild this area as it was in the 1600's. By their use of the Endangered Species Act they have all but stopped logging to save an owl that is being eradicated by another owl and NOT logging; farming and ranching because they want to use the water to save the salmon when there are other ways of doing so; they have stopped mining, also because of the salmon, and they are not telling the truth.

Films have been made of dredging showing the fish slowly swimming around the dredging. And it is proven that the dredging creates cool holes for spawning of the salmon as well as removing mercury from the river bed. Dredging only occurs when it will not harm the tiny salmon. They also want our Green Dams removed as they are "Unsustainable." They already have formed, in a 100 mile radius, from Yreka, Transition Towns for "Sustainable Development." Mt. Shasta is # 18 and is registered with the United Nations.

These problems and more are somewhat different than the problems along the coast.
