

Summary of CRC's Instructions to Line Drawers, Regions I, II, and III, May 19, 2011, Auburn

- Pomona Valley – Pomona, Montclair, Ontario, and Chino, but not Chino Hills – population approx. 515,500

- Riverside and Moreno Valley too big to combine so to be split into 2 metro areas

Riverside Metro – Riverside plus El Sobrante and Junupa Valley, but not Eastvale – pop. approx. 431,500

Moreno Valley Metro – Moreno Valley plus Perris, Mead Valley, Lake Matthews, Hemet, March AFB, but not Menifee – pop. approx 470,000

Riverside County to be in 1 BofE district

- Beware of narrow, thin stretch along I-15
- Coachella Valley – with Palo Verde, but without Banning or Beaumont, approx. pop. 445,500

- San Bernardino – split into two metro areas, possible Section 2 districts, east/west division

San Bernardino Metro A – w/ Rialto, Fontana, Colton, and Bloomington

San Bernardino Metro B – w/ Crestline, Lake Arrowhead, Loma Linda, Redlands, Grand Terrace, Oak Glen, Big Bear

- Imperial County – keep undivided and perhaps include around Salton Sea, or with border district west into south San Diego County, without Coronado, but include part of Chula Vista
- Coastal San Diego – from Oceanside down to Escondido
- Northwest San Diego County – Camp Pendleton, Carlsbad, San Marcos, and Vista
- Northeast San Diego County – Poway with Ramona, Julian, Borrego Springs, Alpine, part of City of San Diego
- City of San Diego – Mira Mesa, Rancho Penasquitos, Carmel Valley, west to Hwy 5 and east to Hwy. 8
- Central San Diego – part of Chula Vista, National City, Paradise Hills
- South San Diego - Barrio District of San Diego, south part of City of San Diego, part of Chula Vista

Note for all of San Diego – keep ethnic neighborhoods together

- Keep Lemon Grove and Spring Valley together
- Santa Ana and Anaheim too big to keep together and not contiguous, maybe one congressional district, maybe Santa Ana and central portion of Anaheim (Latino), but need to be contiguous
- South Orange County – south of Irvine, but do not include Lake Forest
- Coastal Orange County – Seal Beach to Newport Beach or Laguna Beach
- North Orange County – Buena Park, Fullerton, Placentia, La Habra, all area north of Hwy. 91
- Keep Little Saigon together with other API areas of COI in Orange County, including Artesia and Cerritos, and also include Artesia and Cypress, even though this goes across county line into LA County
- Irvine, Tustin and N. Tustin, with Lake Forest

Note for all districts, do not cross county lines unless directed by Commission or raise VRA issue if crossing county lines is indicated
