To whom it may concern,

As a resident of the City of Fountain Valley, I would like to state that we share a "Community of Interest" with Huntington Beach and Costa Mesa, not Santa Ana. The current maps align us with Santa Ana.

Examples:

1. We **share a high school district** including school facilities with Huntington Beach. Three of my children went to Fountain Valley H.S. and held their graduation ceremonies at Huntington Beach H.S. Two other children lived in Fountain Valley and went to Marina H.S. in Huntington Beach. Students interested in the arts attend Huntington Beach H.S. as a magnet for the district. Our **school board** members come from both cities.
2. **Sports teams** share facilities with Huntington Beach including ice hockey. Fountain Valley children go to **SCATS** in Huntington Beach for gymnastics. Fountain Valley and Edison High (H.B.) share the largest sport competition with their annual football game.
3. We shop, eat and play at **Bella Terra in Huntington Beach** and South **Coast Plaza in Costa Mesa**.
4. **The 405 Fwy.** conveniently links us to malls and entertainment with our Huntington Beach and Costa Mesa neighbors.
5. We share **service groups** such as Rotary and Kiwanis with Huntington Beach.
6. We **live** in Fountain Valley and **work** in Huntington Beach.
7. Huntington Beach **Library** provides us with our most complete research materials. Our students study there.
8. Our children attend **community college** in Huntington Beach(Golden West) and Costa Mesa(Orange Coast).
9. We share the same Orange County Sanitation District.

For this reason we ask that we be included with the City of Huntington Beach in upcoming redistricting maps.
