

The Evergreen District of San Jose is a diverse community which is united by common interests. It is usually associated with San Jose City Council District 8. The boundaries of this district are Ocala/Marten to the north, and the end of San Jose's residential development in the south (usually associated with the southern tip of the California Oak Creek residential development). The entire area is within the city of San Jose and Santa Clara County.

Despite these changes, the community has retained its identity separate from the surrounding areas. Our values include concerns with traffic, environment, schools, & the quality of life. We participate in community activities, shop, & have friends in this area. We actively support our local elected officials.

We are members of the District 8 Community Round Table (D8CRT), which promotes activities and communication between the City Council District 8 and our neighbors. There are also three community groups with Evergreen in their name: GoingEvergreen, focused on green technology & awareness, Evergreen Business and Professional Association, and Involved Evergreen, focused on the area surrounding Evergreen Village Square.


The proposed Congressional, State Senate & State Assembly districts will all split up the Evergreen area. Some residents will be merged with our neighbors to the north, some as far away as Hayward in Alameda County. Others will be merged with neighbors in the south in remote areas of Monterey County. The Congressional District contains most of Evergreen, but splits up the Silver Creek area and the Villages retirement community.

Please keep the Evergreen area intact as much as possible. Do not put us into different counties or with areas with different values & concerns from our own. The San Jose City Redistricting Committee recently made extra efforts to keep our area together. Similarly, the Santa Clara County Redistricting Committee approved new maps that kept the Evergreen community together under one supervisorial district. Please keep our Evergreen community together. Thank you.
