California Redistricting Commission – CRC

Last night, at Fort Mason Center in San Francisco, I was proud and humbled to be a very small part of a mighty team of volunteers from Contra Costa and Alameda counties testifying before The California Citizens Redistricting Commission (CCRC). Many of this group spent last Friday night in Stockton, Saturday in San Jose, and will spend tonight in Sacramento, testifying before the Commission!

The threat last night was that the Commission might put the city of San Ramon in a Congressional District with Fremont, Newark, Union City and Hayward, and put the cities of Dublin, Pleasanton, and Livermore into a Congressional District with San Jose! This would have separated the San Ramon Valley from the Tri-Valley and totally isolated the City of San Ramon into a deep blue district. It makes no sense whatsoever!

The Contra Costa/Alameda Redistricting Team gave a coordinated presentation, backed-up by state-wide maps that gave the CRC practical ways to meet our wishes, while still fulfilling their legal requirements. Additionally, the leaders of our group have reached out to Republicans, Conservatives, and others in other areas of the State to coordinate map-drawing efforts and avoid the dreaded "ripple effect", where one group's desired district ruins all others.

To the members of the California Citizens Redistricting Commission:

As constituents of the draft Senate district EALAM, we are calling upon you to assign an odd number to our district as you go through the process of numbering the districts. The majority of our district is now in Senate District 7. It is an odd-numbered district, and we are due to elect our next Senator in 2012. If you choose to make our Senate district an even-numbered district there will be no election for State Senator until 2014. Thus, our current Senator will need to step down leaving us with no legitimate representation in the State Senate for two years. It is unacceptable to disenfranchise the residents and businesses of Contra Costa county in this manner. Contra Costa county is the 9th largest county by population with over a million people.

I strongly urge you to retain our district as an odd-numbered district so that the residents and businesses of Contra Costa county are not disenfranchised.
