This is an integral valley both geographically and economically and it needs to remain as such.

Napa Valler Register: "During a meeting of the Napa County Transportation and Planning Agency on Thursday 6/16/2011, delegates from across the county echoed American Canyon's complaints.

"It makes sense to preserve the continuity of the valley," said Jim Krider, chair of transit agency's board of directors and Napa city councilman.

Officials from across the valley argue that American Canyon is an integral part of Napa's wine industry and the regional economy, providing valuable housing, warehousing and transportation for a county where agricultural space is carefully guarded.

Putting it in with Sonoma and Marin counties for the state legislature, or Solano and Yolo counties in Congress, would be detrimental to the city and all of Napa County, they say."
